



RE: UQ Cricket Club Country Cricket Scholarship

Purpose

The purpose of UQ Cricket Club Country Cricket Scholarship is to provide support to outstanding new or continuing UQ Cricket Club members who have demonstrated exceptional ability in their chosen sport of cricket to combine a tertiary education, trade apprenticeship or career with high-performance sport.

This Scholarship is awarded based on the yearly available funding from UQ Cricket Club and donors. This Scholarship has a three-year term and is open to new and continuing UQ Cricket Club members.

Statement of Donor Intent

UQ Cricket Club's purpose is to provide opportunities for members and the community to connect, play and enjoy the game of cricket. The donor (TRiiBE Finance) wishes to support this goal by establishing a tertiary education, trade apprenticeship or career scholarship for UQ Cricket Club members who are from rural or remote areas in Australia.

Eligibility and selection criteria

Selection of each scholarship is based on the applicant's:

1. Current or previous geographical location in Australia being classified as rural or remote
2. New or continuing UQ Cricket Club member
3. Currently studying at a recognised tertiary education provider, has a current and ongoing trade apprenticeship or is relocating to Brisbane to pursue a career opportunity.

Applicants will be asked to provide information and documentation to support their Scholarship application. All applicants will be required to provide the following:

- Contact details
- Confirmation of current enrolment at a tertiary institution, employment at a trade apprenticeship or a letter from current employer
- Representative sporting history from the last 2 years
- Personal statement including how you will have a positive, meaningful and lasting impact on UQ Cricket Club on and off the field.

- Year 3 - Payment of UQCC membership fees
